13. (Week of November 20, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Deuteronomy 4-5****Memory Verse:** *"You shall have no other gods before me"* (Deut. 5:7 ESV).**Sun:** Deuteronomy 4:1-14 – According to verse 13, what is the covenant God commanded Israel to perform?**Mon:** Deuteronomy 4:15-24 – Why should we not make a physical image to represent God as an aid in our worship of him?**Tue:** Deuteronomy 4:25-31 – What warnings and promises does Moses give to Israel in these verses?**Wed:** Deuteronomy 4:32-40 – How is the LORD God of Israel unique? What then should be our response to him?**Thu:** Deuteronomy 5:1-11 – Review the first three commandments of the covenant the LORD made with Israel at Horeb (Sinai). Name some specific ways we might break these commandments.**Fri:** Deuteronomy 5:12-21 – Review the last seven of the Ten Commandments. Name some specific ways we might break these commandments.**Sat:** Deuteronomy 5:22-33 – What was the response of the people to the giving of the Ten Commandments?

14. (Week of November 27, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Deuteronomy 6-8****Memory Verse:** *"You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might"* (Deut. 6:5 ESV).**Sun:** Deuteronomy 6:1-9 – What is the most important commandment (v. 5)? (See Matthew 22:34-40.) What responsibility is given here to parents?**Mon:** Deuteronomy 6:10-19 – What warnings does Moses give to the people of Israel?**Tue:** Deuteronomy 6:20-26 – What example of dialogue between parent and child do you see here? How can you follow this example?**Wed:** Deuteronomy 7:1-11 – How were the Israelites to deal with the peoples of Canaan when they entered the Promised Land and why? Why did God choose the nation Israel?**Thu:** Deuteronomy 7:12-26 – What promises does God make to Israel in these verses?**Fri:** Deuteronomy 8:1-10 – How did God deal with Israel in the past, and how does he promise to deal with them in the future?**Sat:** Deuteronomy 8:11-20 – What warnings does God give to Israel in these verses? Are you in danger of the "forgetting" the LORD your God? What steps can we take to "remember" him?**Home Bible Reading Schedule****Weeks 13-16**

15. (Week of December 4, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Deuteronomy 9-11****Memory Verse:** *"And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul"* (Deut. 10:12 ESV)**Sun:** Deuteronomy 9:1-12 – Why was the LORD going to drive out the inhabitants of Canaan from before Israel?**Mon:** Deuteronomy 9:13-21, 25-29 – Why did God not destroy the people of Israel for making the golden calf?**Tue:** Deuteronomy 10:1-5, 10-11 – How does this passage show the importance of the Ten Commandments?**Wed:** Deuteronomy 10:12-22 – What did the LORD require of his people Israel? What does he require of us?**Thu:** Deuteronomy 11:1-12 – What incentives does God give Israel to love and obey him?**Fri:** Deuteronomy 11:13-25 – Repeat yesterday's question. Also, what responsibility is given to parents in verses 18-21?**Sat:** Deuteronomy 11:26-32 – What is the blessing and the curse that God sets before the people?

16. (Week of December 11, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Deuteronomy 29-31****Memory Verse:** *If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved* (Rom. 10:9 ESV).**Sun:** Deuteronomy 29:1-9 – In the land of Moab, just before the people enter the Promised Land, God renews his covenant with Israel. What had the LORD done for Israel during the previous forty years?**Mon:** Deuteronomy 29:10-15 – With whom was God making this covenant?**Tue:** Deuteronomy 29:16-29 – What warnings does God give to Israel in these verses?**Wed:** Deuteronomy 30:1-10 – What promises does God give to Israel in these verses?**Thu:** Deuteronomy 30:11-20 – What choice does Moses place before the people in these verses? Compare Romans 10:6-12.**Fri:** Deuteronomy 31:1-13 – What provision did Moses make for the future leadership of Israel? What provision did he make so that the people would remember the covenant?**Sat:** Deuteronomy 31:14-18, 23-29 – Repeat yesterday's questions. Are you remembering the covenant God has made with you?
