

33. (Week of April 9, 2017)

God's Covenant in the Psalms**Psalm 106**

Memory Verse: *Praise the LORD! Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!* (Ps. 106:1 ESV).

Sun: Psalm 106:1-5 – For what does the psalmist praise the LORD (vv. 1-3)? For what does he pray (vv. 4-5)?

Mon: Psalm 106:6-12 – How did Israel sin at the Red Sea? What was the LORD's response?

Tue: Psalm 106:13-23 – List the occasions of Israel's sin in these verses. Why did the LORD not destroy them completely?

Wed: Psalm 106:24-33 – Repeat yesterday's questions.

Thu: Psalm 106:34-39 – Once Israel reached the Promised Land, what further sins did the people commit?

Fri: Psalm 106:40-43 – How did God respond to Israel's rebellion?

Sat: Psalm 106:44-48 – Why did the LORD not give up on his people? What is the final prayer of the psalmist in verse 47? What have you learned about God in this psalm?

34. (Week of April 16, 2017)

God's Covenant with David in the Prophets**Isaiah 9:1-7; 11; 55:1-5; Jeremiah 23:1-8; 30:1-9; 33:14-26**

Memory Verse: *For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace* (Isaiah 9:6 ESV).

Sun: Isaiah 9:1-7 – How does the famous prophecy of verses 6-7 relate to God's covenant with David? How has this covenant been fulfilled?

Mon: Isaiah 11:1-9 – What is the significance of the "shoot from the stump of Jesse" (v. 1)? How does Jesus Christ fulfill this prophecy?

Tue: Isaiah 11:10-16 – Notice the reference to "the root of Jesse" in verse 10. What further prophecies are made in this passage?

Wed: Isaiah 55:1-5 – To what does Isaiah refer in verse 3: "I will make with you an everlasting covenant, my steadfast, sure love for David"? Compare Acts 13:34.

Thu: Jeremiah 23:1-8 – Who is the "righteous Branch" whom the LORD promised to raise up for David?

Fri: Jeremiah 30:1-9 – What promises does the LORD make to Israel in these verses?

Sat: Jeremiah 33:14-26 – What does the LORD say in this passage about the covenant he made with David?

35. (Week of April 23, 2017)

God's Covenant in Isaiah**Isaiah 42:1-9; 49:1-13; 52:13-53:12; 54; 56:1-8; 59:15b-21; 61**

Memory Verse: *All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all* (Isa. 53:6 ESV).

Sun: Isaiah 42:1-9 – How does Jesus fulfill this "servant of the LORD" prophecy? Compare Matthew 12:15-21. Notice the reference to "covenant" in Isaiah 42:6.

Mon: Isaiah 49:1-13 – How does Jesus fulfill this "servant of the LORD" prophecy? Compare Acts 13:13:44-47. Notice the reference to "covenant" in Isaiah 49:8.

Tue: Isaiah 52:13-53:12 – How does Jesus fulfill this "servant of the LORD" prophecy?

Wed: Isaiah 54:1-10 – What is the "covenant of peace" in verse 10? How is it like God's promise to Noah?

Thu: Isaiah 56:1-8 – What promises does the LORD make to eunuchs and foreigners who hold fast to his covenant?

Fri: Isaiah 59:15b-21 – What covenant does the LORD make with his people in verses 20-21? Compare Romans 11:25-27.

Sat: Isaiah 61:1-11 – How does Jesus fulfill this prophecy? Compare Luke 4:16-21. Notice the reference to "covenant" in Isaiah 61:8.

36. (Week of April 30, 2017)

God's Old and New Covenants in Jeremiah**Jeremiah 3:6-18; 11:1-13; 14:19-22;****22:1-9; 31:27-40; 32; 34:8-22; 50:1-5**

Memory Verse: *"For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more"* (Jeremiah 31:34b ESV).

Sun: Jeremiah 3:6-18 – What promises does the LORD give to Israel and Judah in verses 15-18?

Mon: Jeremiah 11:1-13 – Which of God's covenants did Israel break?

Tue: Jeremiah 14:19-22 – On what basis does Jeremiah plead for Israel?

Wed: Jeremiah 22:1-9 – According to verse 9, why would the LORD bring judgment on the city of Jerusalem?

Thu: Jeremiah 31:27-40 – Compare the old covenant with the new covenant. If you have time, see Hebrews 8:6-13.

Fri: Jeremiah 32:36-44 – What is the "everlasting covenant" of verse 40? Compare Jeremiah 50:4-5.

Sat: Jeremiah 34:8-22 – How did the people of Israel transgress the old covenant?
