

Home Bible Reading Schedule**Weeks 9-12**

9. (Week of October 23, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Exodus 19–24; 31:12-18**

Memory Verse: *"This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood"* (Luke 22:20b ESV).

Sun: Exodus 19:1-15 – What promises did God make to Israel in verses 5-6? On what condition? What was the response of the people (v. 8)?

Mon: Exodus 19:16-25 – Describe the scene when the LORD came down on Mt. Sinai. How does this scene make you feel?

Tue: Exodus 20:1-11 – What had the LORD already done for Israel (v. 2)? What commands does he now give them in relation to himself (vv. 3-11)?

Wed: Exodus 20:12-21 – What commands does God give Israel in relation to others? Review all Ten Commandments. How do you measure up?

Thu: Exodus 24:1-8 – The "Book of the Covenant" (v. 7) refers to all the instructions God gave Israel in Exodus 20–23. How did the people respond to these instructions (24:3, 7)? Compare Exodus 24:8 with our memory verse, Luke 22:20.

Fri: Exodus 24:9-18 – Describe the communion that a select group of Israelites had with the God of Israel in verses 9-11.

Sat: Exodus 31:12-18 – What special function did the Sabbath commandment serve in the relationship between God and Israel?

10. (Week of October 30, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Exodus 32–34**

Memory Verse: *Little children, keep yourselves from idols* (1 John 5:21 ESV).

Sun: Exodus 32:1-14 – How did the Israelites break the covenant God made with them? On what basis did Moses plead with God for Israel (v. 13)?

Mon: Exodus 32:15-20, 30-34 – What was Moses' response to the sin of the people?

Tue: Exodus 32:35; 33:1-6 – What was the LORD's response to the sin of the people?

Wed: Exodus 33:12-23 – What was the result of Moses' intercession for the people? Spend time in intercession for others.

Thu: Exodus 34:1-9 – What does the LORD reveal to Moses of his "glory"? What was Moses' response? Worship the LORD!

Fri: Exodus 34:10-26 – God renews his covenant with Israel after the incident of the golden calf. Summarize his instructions.

Sat: Exodus 34:27-35 – What words does the LORD inscribe on a new set of stone tablets (vv. 27-28)? What is the significance of Moses' shining face? (See 2 Cor. 3:6-18.)

Home Bible Reading Schedule**Weeks 9-12**

11. (Week of November 6, 2016)

God's Covenant with Abraham**Exodus 25–31; 35–40**

Memory Verse: *Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?* (1 Cor. 3:16 ESV)

Sun: Exodus 25:1-9; 35:4-9 – What was the purpose of the tabernacle in the wilderness (25:8)? Where does God dwell now?

Mon: Exodus 35:20-29 – What was the response of the people to the request for contributions? Evaluate your own giving.

Tue: Exodus 35:10-19, 30-35; 36:1 – How were Bezalel, Oholiab, and others equipped to construct the tabernacle? What gifts has God given to you?

Wed: Exodus 40:1-8 – What was the purpose of these various pieces of furniture in the tabernacle?

Thu: Exodus 40:9-15 – What was the significance of this anointing of the tabernacle and the priests?

Fri: Exodus 40:16-33 – Notice the repeated emphasis on obedience. Are you obeying the Lord in your life and service?

Sat: Exodus 40:34-38 – What was the significance of the cloud? How does God dwell among his people today? (See the memory verse.)

12. (Week of November 13, 2016)

God's Covenant with Israel**Leviticus 16; 26**

Memory Verse: *Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins* (Heb. 9:22b ESV).

Sun: Leviticus 16:1-14 – What arrangement did God make for Aaron to enter into the most Holy Place of the tabernacle?

Mon: Leviticus 16:15-28 – What arrangement did God make for atonement of the sins of the people?

Tue: Leviticus 16:29-34 – What is the significance of the day of atonement?

Wed: Hebrews 9:1-14 – How is the sacrifice of Christ under the new covenant superior to the sacrifices made on the day of atonement under the old covenant?

Thu: Leviticus 26:1-13 – What blessings did God promise to Israel if they would obey his covenant?

Fri: Leviticus 26:14-33 – With what punishments did God threaten Israel if they broke his covenant?

Sat: Leviticus 26:34-46 – Why does the LORD promise to restore Israel if they repent of their sins?
