Jesus' Birth and Childhood**Luke 1-2****Memory Verse:** *"For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord"* (Luke 2:11 ESV).**Sun:** Luke 1:1-25 - How and why did Luke write his Gospel? What was to be the mission of Zechariah's son, John?**Mon:** Luke 1:26-38 - What was to be the mission of Mary's Son, Jesus?**Tues:** Luke 1:39-56 - Use Mary's song of praise as a basis for your own time of worship.**Wed:** Luke 1:57-80 - Use Zechariah's song of praise as a basis for your own time of worship.**Thu:** Luke 2:1-20 - What do you learn from the humble circumstances of Jesus' birth? According to verse 11, who is Jesus?**Fri:** Luke 2:21-40 - What do Simeon and Anna tell us about Jesus?**Sat:** Luke 2:41-52 - How was the childhood of Jesus like that of every child? How was he unique?

02. (Week of March 6, 2016)

Preparation for Jesus' Public Ministry**Luke 3:1-4:13****Memory Verse:** *"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased"* (Luke 3:22 ESV).**Sun:** Luke 3:1-6 - How does Luke relate his story 1) to secular history? 2) to Old Testament prophecy?**Mon:** Luke 3:7-14 - What is the evidence of true repentance? Is there any area of your life that needs to change?**Tues:** Luke 3:15-20 - What does John the Baptist teach us here about Jesus Christ?**Wed:** Luke 3:21-22 - What example does Jesus set for us here? Have you been baptized?**Thu:** Luke 3:23-38 - How does Luke show that Jesus was truly a man?**Fri:** Luke 4:1-8 - What do you learn here about temptation and how to overcome it?**Sat:** Luke 4:9-13 - Repeat Friday's question.**Home Bible Reading Schedule****Weeks 1-4**

03. (Week of March 13, 2016)

Jesus' Ministry in Galilee**Luke 4:14-6:11****Memory Verse:** *"I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance"* (Luke 5:32 ESV).**Sun:** Luke 4:14-30 - How was Jesus received in his home town of Nazareth? Why was he treated this way? How does he describe his mission?**Mon:** Luke 4:31-44 - Over what realms does Jesus show his authority by these miracles?**Tues:** Luke 5:1-11 - Repeat Monday's question. Also, what lessons in "spiritual fishing" was he teaching his disciples?**Wed:** Luke 5:12-26 - What truths about Christ do you learn from these two miracles? What example does he set for us in verse 16?**Thu:** Luke 5:27-32 - How should we relate to "sinners"?**Fri:** Luke 5:33-39 - How would you interpret Jesus' parables in verses 36-39?**Sat:** Luke 6:1-11 - What kinds of activities did Jesus affirm as appropriate on the Sabbath?

04. (Week of March 20, 2016)

Jesus' Ministry in Galilee (cont.)**Luke 6:12-7:50****Memory Verse:** *"Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you?"* (Luke 6:46 ESV)**Sun:** Luke 6:12-19 - How did Jesus select his 12 disciples? Any lessons for us?**Mon:** Luke 6:20-26 - How is Jesus' teaching a reversal of the world's values?**Tues:** Luke 6:27-42 - Summarize Jesus' teaching on love for enemies and on judging. Where is change needed in your life?**Wed:** Luke 6:43-49 - What is the main point of each of these illustrations?**Thu:** Luke 7:1-17 - What special powers does Jesus demonstrate in these two miracles?**Fri:** Luke 7:18-35 - What do you learn here about the respective ministries of Jesus and John the Baptist?**Sat:** Luke 7:36-50 - What does Jesus teach this Pharisee about faith, forgiveness, and love?
