Weeks 9-12

09. (Week of April 24, 2016)

Jesus Journeying Toward Jerusalem: Third Stage

Luke 17:11-19:27

Memory Verse: "Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God" (Luke 18:16 ESV).

- Sun:** Luke 17:11-19 - What does this incident teach us about faith, gratitude, and prejudice?
- Mon:** Luke 17:20-37 - What does Jesus teach about the nature of God's Kingdom (vv. 20, 21)? About the future revelation of the Son of Man? (vv. 22-37)
- Tues:** Luke 18:1-14 - What is the chief lesson of each parable? Which parable more addresses a need in your own life?
- Wed:** Lk 18:15-30 - What should be our attitude toward little children? Toward material wealth? Where is change most needed in your life?
- Thu:** Luke 18:31-43 - What connection do you see between the disciples response in v. 34 and the miracle of 18:35-43?
- Fri:** Luke 19:1-10 - How does the story of Zacchaeus illustrate the truth of v.10? Why did Jesus draw the conclusion of verse 9?
- Sat:** Luke 19:11-27 - Compare this parable to the parable of the talents in Matthew 25:14-30. What similar lessons are taught? Any different lessons?

10. (Week of May 1, 2016)

Jesus' Ministry in Jerusalem

Luke 18:28-21:38

Memory Verse: "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away" (Luke 21:33 ESV).

- Sun:** Luke 18:28-44 - At last, Jerusalem! What kind of reception did Jesus get? Why did Jesus weep over the city?
- Mon:** Luke 19:45-20:8 - What was the source of Jesus' authority? Why did he not give the religious leaders a direct answer to their question?
- Tues:** Luke 20:9-19 - Give an explanation of Jesus' parable.
- Wed:** Luke 20:20-40 - Summarize Jesus' teaching on 1) our duty to the state and 2) the resurrection.
- Thu:** Luke 20:41-21:4 - How would you answer Jesus' question in verse 44? How does he show his regard for widows?
- Fri:** Luke 21:5-19 - Which of these signs do you see evident today? What direct commands or instruction does Jesus give his disciples?
- Sat:** Luke 21:20-38 - How should we be preparing for the return of the Lord?

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11. (Week of May 8, 2016)

Jesus' Passion

Luke 22:1-65

Memory Verse: "Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done" (Luke 22:42 ESV).

- Sun:** Luke 22:1-6 - What was the role of the religious leaders, Judas, and Satan in the decision to kill Jesus?
- Mon:** Luke 22:7-23 - What is the connection between the Passover and the Lord's Supper?
- Tues:** Luke 22:24-30 - What is the nature of true greatness? Its reward? List ways that we can serve.
- Wed:** Luke 22:31-38 - What encouragement and warning can we receive from Jesus' conversation with Peter?
- Thu:** Luke 22:39-46 - What unique features does Luke include in this scene of Christ's agony? What special truths do these details convey?
- Fri:** Luke 22:47-53 - What characteristics of Jesus impress you in this arrest scene in the Garden?
- Sat:** Luke 22:54-65 - What practical lessons can we learn from the story of Peter's denial?

12. (Week of May 15, 2016)

Jesus' Passion (cont.)

Luke 22:66-23:56

Memory Verse: "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise"(Luke 23:43 ESV).

- Sun:** Luke 22:66-71 - What claim does Jesus now make before the Jewish ruling council?
- Mon:** Luke 23:1-12 - What were the charges brought against Jesus before the Roman government? Describe the response of Herod and Jesus to each other.
- Tues:** Luke 23:13-25 - Describe the character of Pilate and his handling of Jesus' trial. What was his verdict?
- Wed:** Luke 23:26-34 - What characteristics of Jesus shine forth in his words to the women and his prayer for his executioners?
- Thu:** Luke 23:35-43 - Why was Jesus mocked? What truths about salvation can you find in the story of the penitent thief? Will you be with Christ in Paradise?
- Fri:** Luke 23:44-49 - Comment on what impresses you in this death scene of Jesus Christ.
- Sat:** Luke 23:50-56 - Why is the burial of Jesus significant?
