

13. (Week of May 20, 2018)

Timothy (2)

Memory Verse: *And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also.*

2 Tim 2:2 (ESV)

- Sun:** 2 Timothy 1:1-7 – What do you learn in these verses about Timothy and his background? Who has God used to influence your spiritual life?
- Mon:** 2 Timothy 1:8-18 – What instructions does Paul give to Timothy? How was Paul's own life an encouraging example to Timothy?
- Tue:** 2 Timothy 2:1-13 – Unpack the meaning of each metaphor in verses 3-6. How could Timothy face the demands of Christian service (vv. 1, 7)?
- Wed:** 2 Timothy 2:14-26 – What are some situations where you could apply verses 22-26 in your own life?
- Thu:** 2 Timothy 3:1-17 – Summarize the characteristics of the last days (vv. 1-13). How can we stand firm in such evil days (vv. 1-17)?
- Fri:** 2 Timothy 4:1-5 – What final charge does Paul give to Timothy?
- Sat:** 2 Timothy 4:6-22; Heb. 13:23 – How did Paul face the prospect of death? Why did he request Timothy to come to him? Was Timothy true to Paul's overall charge to him in this letter?

01. (Week of May 27, 2018)

Eve

Memory verse: *The LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him."*

Gen 2:18 (NIV)

- Sun:** Genesis 1:26-31 – What does this passage teach us about the creation and status of woman?
- Mon:** Genesis 2:7-9, 15-25; 1 Corinthians 11:8-9, 11-12 – What additional details do these verses supply about the creation of woman? For what purpose did God create her?
- Tue:** Genesis 3:1-7 – What role did the woman play in the fall of the human race into sin? What role did the man play? (See Romans 5:12.)
- Wed:** Genesis 3:8-24 – What was God's judgment on the woman for her sin? On the man? What hope is given to the woman in verses 15, 20-21?
- Thu:** Genesis 4:1-8 – How did Eve feel about the birth of her first son? How do you think she would have felt after verse 8?
- Fri:** Genesis 4:25–5:5 – How did Eve feel after the birth of her third son? Compare Genesis 5:1-3 with 1:26-28.
- Sat:** 2 Corinthians 11:1-4; 1 Timothy 2:9-15 – What lessons does Paul draw from the life of Eve?

02. (Week of June 3, 2018)

Sarah

Memory Verse: *"Is anything too hard for the LORD?"* Gen 18:14a (NIV)

- Sun:** Genesis 11:27–12:9 – What was Sarai's special trial? Pray for any women you know who are hoping to have children.
- Mon:** Genesis 12:10-20 – Evaluate Abram's treatment of his wife Sarai in this story. How did God protect her? (If time, compare this passage with Genesis 20:1-18.)
- Tue:** Genesis 16:1-16 – What wrongs do you see in Sarai's conduct here? How might we commit the same sins?
- Wed:** Genesis 17:1-8, 15-22 – What special promises did God make to Abraham? To Sarah?
- Thu:** Genesis 18:1-15; 1 Peter 3:6 – What was not commendable about Sarah's conduct in this story? What does Peter say was commendable about her character and conduct? (Compare verse 12 with 1 Peter 3:6.)
- Fri:** Genesis 21:1-21 (Romans 4:18-21; 9:6-9; Heb 11:11-12) – How did God show his grace to Sarah? What important role did Sarah play in God's salvation plan?
- Sat:** Genesis 23:1-20; 25:7-10 – Evaluate Abraham's care of his wife Sarah at the time of her death.

03. (Week of June 10, 2018)

Rebekah

Memory Verse: *He who finds a wife finds what is good and receives favor from the LORD.*

Prov (18:22 NIV)

- Sun:** Genesis 22:20-23; 24:1-4, 10-28 – What outstanding qualities do you see in Rebekah? Pray for Christian mates for the young men and women of our church.
- Mon:** Genesis 24:29-33, 50-67 – What principles for finding a life mate do you find in this story?
- Tue:** Genesis 25:19-28; Romans 9:10-12 – What qualities, both good and bad, do you see in Rebekah and Isaac? How did God overrule their choices?
- Wed:** Genesis 26:1-11, 34-35 – What trials did Rebekah endure? How did God protect her?
- Thu:** Genesis 27:1-17 – Evaluate the motives and actions of Rebekah in this story. How do these events relate to Genesis 25:28?
- Fri:** Genesis 27:18-29, 41-45 – What was the outcome of the sin of Rebekah and Jacob?
- Sat:** Genesis 27:46–28:9 – How did God overrule the sinful action of Rebekah and Jacob to accomplish his purposes?
