Timothy (1)

Memory Verse: *Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.*

1 Tim 4:12 (ESV)

- Sun:** 2 Timothy 1:5; 3:15; Acts 16:1-5 – What do you learn here about Timothy's early life and call to ministry? What lessons can we apply from these examples?
- Mon:** Acts 17:1, 13-15; 1 Thess 1:1; 2:17-3:10; 2 Thess 1:1 – What was Timothy's role in the ministry at Thessalonica?
- Tue:** Acts 18:1, 5; 2 Cor 1:19; Acts 19:21-22; 1 Cor 4:14-17; 16:10-11 – What was Timothy's role in the ministry at Corinth? What was Paul's estimate of Timothy?
- Wed:** Philippians 1:1; 2:19-24 (Col 1:1; Philemon 1) – We have jumped ahead in time to Paul's first Roman imprisonment. What was Paul's estimate of Timothy?
- Thu:** 1 Timothy 1:1-7, 18-20; 3:14-16 – What assignment had Paul given to Timothy in Ephesus?
- Fri:** 1 Timothy 4:6-5:2 – List the things Timothy must do in order to be a "good minister of Jesus Christ."
- Sat:** 1 Timothy 5:17-25; 6:11-16, 20-21 – What serious responsibilities does Paul give to Timothy?

06. (Week of April 1, 2018)

Aquila & Priscilla; Apollos

Memory verse: *Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.*

1 Cor 12:4 (ESV)

- Sun:** Acts 18:1-11 – What special role did Aquila and Priscilla play in Paul's ministry? How does God use "tent-maker" missionaries in the world today?
- Mon:** Acts 18:18-21, 24-28; 19:1 – What do you learn here about the character and gifts of Apollos? What special role did Aquila and Priscilla play in his ministry?
- Tue:** 1 Corinthians 16:19; Romans 16:3-5; 2 Timothy 4:19 – Comment on the travels, the hospitality, and the sacrifice of Aquila and Priscilla. How is your home being used for Christ?
- Wed:** 1 Corinthians 1:1-3, 10-17 – What caused the division in the church at Corinth? How may similar division arise in the church today?
- Thu:** 1 Corinthians 3:1-9 – Repeat Wednesday's questions. Also, distinguish between the roles of Paul, Apollos, and God in planting the church in Corinth.
- Fri:** 1 Corinthians 3:10-23 – According to verses 21-23, how should we view various Christian leaders?
- Sat:** 1 Corinthians 4:6-13; 16:12; Titus 3:12-13 – What was Paul's estimate of Apollos? ?

07. (Week of April 8, 2018)

Lesser Lights (1)

Memory Verse: *And there are varieties of service, but the same Lord.*

1 Cor 12:5 (ESV)

- Sun:** Sergius Paulus; Bar-Jesus: Acts 13:6-12 – What was the outcome of this spiritual battle in the lives of Bar-Jesus, Sergius Paulus, and Paul?
- Mon:** Lydia: Acts 16:11-15, 40 – What were the respective roles of Paul, Lydia, and the Lord in Lydia's conversion?
- Tue:** Stephanas: 1 Corinthians 1:13-17; 16:15-18 – What was the special role of Stephanas in the church at Corinth. Have you been baptized? How has God used you since your baptism?
- Wed:** Demetrius: Acts 19:23-41 – Evaluate the motives of Demetrius and his coworkers. How might the gospel challenge businessmen today?
- Thu:** Phoebe: Romans 16:1-2 – Phoebe may have been the carrier of Paul's letter to Rome. How and why does Paul commend her?
- Fri:** Galaxy of saints (1): Romans 16:3-16 – What impresses you about the service of these various saints?
- Sat:** Galaxy of saints (2): Romans 16:21-23 – Repeat yesterday's question.

08. (Week of April 15, 2018)

Felix; Festus; Agrippa

Memory Verse: *But in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect.*

1 Pet 3:15 (ESV)

- Sun:** Acts 23:12-24, 31-35 – How did God protect Paul? Has the Lord ever protected you from some danger?
- Mon:** Acts 24:1-21 – What accusations did Tertullus bring against Paul, and how did Paul answer them? How did Paul turn this legal hearing into an opportunity for witness?
- Tue:** Acts 24:22-27 – What various motives controlled Felix's treatment of Paul? How did Felix respond to Paul's message? Do you ever procrastinate in your response to God's word?
- Wed:** Acts 25:1-12 – Why did Festus want Paul to stand trial in Jerusalem? Why did Paul appeal to Caesar?
- Thu:** Acts 25:13-27 – What do you find commendable in Festus's treatment of Paul?
- Fri:** Acts 26:1-18 – What do you learn from Paul's example about how to give your testimony to others?
- Sat:** Acts 26:19-32 – Repeat yesterday's question. What was the response of Festus and Agrippa to Paul's testimony? Have you met people like Festus and Agrippa?
- Sat:** 1 Timothy 5:17-25; 6:11-16, 20-21 – What serious responsibilities does Paul give to Timothy? ?
