

# Easy Resurrection Rolls

## Ingredients:

- 8 Marshmallows
- 1 package of 8 Crescent Rolls
- ¼ cup butter
- 2 Tbs Cinnamon
- 2 Tbs Sugar

## Also needed:

- one large muffin tin or 2 small ones
- non-stick cooking spray

## Preparations:

1. Preheat Oven: 375 degrees
2. Melt butter 15-20 seconds
3. Mix cinnamon and sugar together in one bowl (equal parts)
4. Spray muffins with non-stick cooking spray

## Instructions:

1. Take 1 marshmallow, roll in the melted butter, then in the cinnamon sugar mixture
2. Carefully wrap the marshmallow in a crescent roll, seal the seams
3. Place the roll in muffin tin
4. Repeat for remaining 7 marshmallows
5. Cook till browned (see crescent roll package directions). Remove from Oven and allow to cool
6. Enjoy!

## Talking Points:

1. The white marshmallow represents Jesus, pure and without sin.
2. The cinnamon and sugar represent Jesus taking our sins (the bad things we do) upon himself. Notice how cinnamon looks dirty on the white marshmallow.
3. After Jesus was crucified for our sins, he was buried in the tomb. Notice we cannot see the marshmallow anymore when it is wrapped in the roll.
4. Once crescent rolls are cooled: cut open a roll: 3 days after Jesus died, some of Jesus's friends and family went to the tomb. But when they came to the tomb, they were surprised. The tomb was open and empty!
5. Jesus came back from the dead and he is still alive today!
